La collection des dessins, des pastels, des miniatures, des estampes, des livres, des manuscrits, des autographes, ainsi que des bois, des cuivres et des pierres lithographiques inscrits sur les inventaires du Louvre, forme l'un des sept départements de ce musée.

Le département des Arts graphiques regroupe trois fonds différents : le Cabinet des dessins, issu de l'ancienne collection des rois de France, la Chalcographie, réunissant les cuivres provenant notamment du Cabinet des planches gravées du roi, et la Collection Edmond de Rothschild.

L'inventaire informatisé du département des Arts graphiques décrit et reproduit les dessins, cartons, pastels et miniatures inscrits sur les inventaires manuscrits du Cabinet des dessins du Musée du Louvre et du Musée d'Orsay. Il comporte également un certain nombre des dessins de la collection Edmond de Rothschild, le fonds des dessins récupérés en Allemagne et attribués aux Musées nationaux par l'Office des Biens privés, le fonds des peintures sur papier et miniatures déposées par le département des Peintures, le fonds des autographes du Cabinet des dessins.

Aujourd'hui, cet inventaire informatisé est riche de plus de 140 000 fiches d'œuvres et de 4 500 fiches d'artistes.



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



Welcome to the Gallery!

The Web Gallery of Art is a virtual museum and searchable database of European painting and sculpture from 12th to mid-19th centuries. It was started in 1996 as a topical site of the Renaissance art, originated in the Italian city-states of the 14th century and spread to other countries in the 15th and 16th centuries. Intending to present Renaissance art as comprehensively as possible, the scope of the collection was later extended to show its Medieval roots as well as its evolution to Baroque and Rococo via Mannerism. More recently the periods of Neoclassicism and Romanticism were also included.

The collection has some of the characteristics of a virtual museum. The experience of the visitors is enhanced by guided tours helping to understand the artistic and historical relationship between different works and artists, by period music of choice in the background and a free postcard service. At the same time the collection serves the visitors' need for a site where various information on art, artists and history can be found together with corresponding pictorial illustrations. Although not a conventional one, the collection is a searchable database supplemented by a glossary containing articles on art terms, relevant historical events, personages, cities, museums and churches.



The Web Gallery of Art is intended to be a free resource of art history primarily for students and teachers. It is a private initiative not related to any museums or art institutions, and not supported financially by any state or corporate sponsors. However, we do our utmost, using authentic literature and advice from professionals, to ensure the quality and authenticity of the content.

L'attività di ricerca si rivolge allo sviluppo di soluzioni per l'archiviazione, la catalogazione, la ricerca e l'analisi di collezioni di sequenze strutturate (archivi relazionali e cataloghi), semi-strutturate (documenti XML) e nonstrutturate (testi o sequenze biologiche).

Alla ricerca di base, Signum affianca la sperimentazione tecnologica e lo sviluppo di applicativi e librerie software utilizzabili dalla comunità scientifica e da enti partner della Scuola Normale Superiore.

Le librerie costituiscono le componenti di base su cui

vengono costruite applicazioni innovative nell'ambito della gestione di archivi e catalogazione di documenti, della compressione dei dati, della linguistica computazionale, del Web e motori di ricerca e della bioinformatica. Alcune di queste applicazioni sono sviluppate dentro Signum, altre si avvalgono di contributi scientifici esterni al Centro e ai quali Signum fornisce l'apporto tecnologico.






